## **Orbograph's Enterprise Recognition Software First in Market to be "Service Pack Ready"**

*New Version 7.12 Includes Service Pack Functionality and Enhanced IQA*

**Billerica, MA, January 15, 2008** – Orbograph Ltd. today announced that its Enterprise recognition software Version 7.12, featuring first-ever service pack functionality, is now available for distribution and installation by business partners and end-user clients.

Service pack functionality has become increasingly important as Orbograph customers are implementing many capabilities on a single platform including: amount recognition, MICR OCR for reject repair, image quality and usability, payee name verification for positive pay, amount verification, image-based fraud detection, check data mining, and BPO.

The "service pack ready" release enables Orbograph resellers and end-users to more quickly certify major enhancements and software fixes for field installation. File modifications are identified within each service pack and can be installed, tested and even uninstalled through the service pack upgrade process.

"By providing new software releases as service pack upgrades, we are addressing a growing requirement of our business partners, certification times for service packs can be significantly lower than for a full release," said Peter Rooney, Director of Client Services at Orbograph Ltd. "As the implementation of Check 21 and image exchange accelerates, demands of end-user clients continue to evolve. Our challenge is to streamline processes and reduce costs so that our partners and customers can reap the benefits and attain their financial targets."

Enterprise Version 7.12 also incorporates eleven new enhancements, including several on the broad topic of IQA, such as the IQA FED Prediction Mode which is designed to emulate FED tests so depositing banks can identify IQA defects in advance of sending images to the FED. "Many community banks receive NCI (non compliant images) which in turn, need to be handled as an exception," explained Vladimir Shapiro, Orbograph's Product Manager of Recognition Solutions. Version 7.12 also features improved performance in Image Integrity testing and internal document IQA with a focus on very low suspect rates. Benchmark results are available upon request.

In many cases, clients do not monitor performance of distributed installations which reduces overall operational efficiency and productivity. Therefore, Orbograph's distributed recognition tools were enhanced in Version 7.12 to insure performance optimization for back and front counter implementations as banks move the capture process to branches.

Barry Cohen, General Manager of Orbograph Ltd., stated, "The use of a service pack methodology for software upgrades, although common in the operating system marketplace and other internet based applications, is a first in our market. It is a competitive advantage for us and of great value to our business partners.
